Last week we received a letter from the HMI who conducted our Ofsted monitoring visit at the beginning of the month. The letter has been published on the Ofsted website and appears on our website under 'Important Information/School Performance'. A monitoring visit cannot alter the school's judgements but the letter states that 'Senior leaders and governors are taking effective action to tackle the areas requiring improvement identified at the last section 5 inspection in order for the school to become good'. The letter and the feedback from the HMI on the day were both very positive.

The children in both classes have been out and about this half term. The Oaks visited the Jorvik Viking Centre and the Dig in York and the Acorns spent a day at Preston Park Museum. They all had a wonderful time and returned to school very excited about everything they had learned and experienced. You can read some of the writing about their visits in our children's newspaper.
