



Where the Music Takes Us – workshop and concert information for schools

Workshop Saturday 18th May – Northallerton School and Sixth Form College (9.45-10.45)

- **This 1 hour workshop is aimed at children who have been studying Vltava, but parents and sibilings would also be welcome to attend.**
Children will be supervised whilst at the workshop but must be signed in and collected by a responsible adult.
- **A coach has been booked to collect children from Linton, Brafferton and Staveley**
The timings are in the attached letter to parents. I will be travelling on the bus, but please make sure you have booked a place for a responsible adult familiar with your group. Please let me know numbers (children and adults) by Friday this week.
- **Workshop led by Trevor Wilson and Northallerton Schools Symphony Orchestra.**
This is the senior ensemble at Northallerton Music Centre. The orchestra will perform the Smetana, show their instruments and your class will be able to join in a final performance. You will need to bring your trolley percussion instruments.
- **Perform your Composition.**
If you have already completed your composition it would be great if you could share it with other schools who have been doing the project. You will need to bring your own instruments, and enough pupils! Please let me know if you would like to do this.

Concert Sunday 23rd June – ‘Locomotion’ Museum, Shildon

- **It is anticipated that families will travel independently to spend the afternoon at the museum**
However if staff would be happy to take a group of children please contact me to discuss transport. There will be a free goodie bag for the first 50 children doing the project who sign up in advance.
- **Activities for children during the afternoon**
These will be provided by the museum.
- **Display of your mural in the exhibition space**
If you would like to have your mural on display please make arrangements for me to collect it the week before.
- **Opportunity to perform your dance at around 3pm**
It would be wonderful if you could perform your dance to an informal audience. You will need to be able to adapt the dance to the specific children who will attend and ensure they are supervised throughout their visit. If you are going to organise transport then please ask me about subsidy. Please let me know if this is possible.
- **4-5pm Full orchestra playing ‘Little Train’ plus other railway and river music**
This will be a chance for the children to hear a live performance and to see the instruments played by excellent musicians. The concert will be suitable for siblings, friends and relations, too.
