Good morning, hope you had lots of fun yesterday. Keep enjoying that sunshine and go out and play.

Phonics: Choose one of Mrs. Jervis's sessions that you haven't done from home learning page.

Go on www.epicphonics.com and click on videos, choose the Phase 4 tricky word song. Then go onto www.phonicsplay.co.uk and play Phase 4 Tricky word trucks (Phase 4 tricky words).

Literacy: We will be working on pencil control today. On home learning page are some handwriting sheets, choose some to have a go at. Try and keep your pencil going during the patterns. Use the sheet in your home learning pack to remember where your letters start, in particular the curly caterpillar letters and one armed robot letters.

Maths: We are continuing with repeating patterns. Could the adult set out a repeating pattern using objects and then challenge your child to continue the pattern. Can they then make a repeating pattern for you to complete (use 2 or 3 different objects no more). Can you find the repeating patterns in the story of We're going on a bear hunt? Then complete the numicon pattern sheet on the home learning page.

Exploring the Arts and Design:

You could: Make a cave for a bear, using blankets for example or outside using natural materials.

Draw/paint/make a bear and where it lives.

Design a bear hunt in your garden or house. Where could you go?

Go on www.charanga.com and use the login sent to you before Easter. Log into Student Yumu and look at Big Bear Funk, listen to the music, dance to the pulse (beat of the music).
