Phonics: Choose a Phonics session from Mrs. Jervis that you haven't done. Can you read these Phase 4 sentences. Remember your sound buttons to help sound out and spot those tricky words.

- 1. Help! I got a bump on the leg.
- 2. A tent will get damp in the rain.
- 3. Milk is good for teeth and gums.

Maths: Watch Numberblocks on Cbeebies iplayer Episode "Fifteen's minute of fame." Go onto www.topmarks.co.uk and play Hit the button, Number bonds to 10 or if confident number bonds to 20.

Make a repeating pattern on the snakes (worksheet on home learning page). Use three different colours. You could make dots, stripes, swirls up to you. You can use a colour more than once. Repeat the pattern on the snake at least 3 times. How many different patterns can you come up with?

Literacy: Practise your one-armed robot letters (worksheet on home learning page). Make sure your letters start in the correct place, remember none of the letters start from the bottom. Can you practice writing these words, thinking carefully about your formation. nap, arm, king, bun.

Finish your story sequencing from yesterday.

Exploring Arts and Design: You could:

Build the houses for the three little pigs

Do potato/sponge printing, can you make a repeating pattern?

Make/draw/paint some pigs. You could build a farm for your pigs.
