

## Instructions for EYFS Monday 20<sup>th</sup> April 2020.

Hello all, I hope you have all had a safe and happy Easter and enjoyed the sunshine we have had. This week our work will be based on the book *We're going on a Bear Hunt*.

**Phonics** Look on the website and see if there are any of Mrs Jervis's phonics lessons you have not done, have a go at one of them.

Go on [www.phonicsplay.co.uk](http://www.phonicsplay.co.uk) and play giggling graphemes phase 3 and also tricky word trucks phase 3 and 4.

**Read *We're going on a Bear Hunt* by Michael Rosen.** If you don't have the book, there is an animated version of the story on You Tube.

**Literacy** Look at the pictures attached, can you cut them out and stick the pictures in the correct sequence in your books. Underneath the pictures write some sentences about the story using the story language eg: Uh oh mud thick, oozy mud. Use your phonics mat to help.

**Maths** Making patterns. We are looking at repeating patterns. Choose objects around your house and make an AB pattern. Some ideas of what you could do below. Take photographs of your patterns and email to me.



Try these patterns too hands up, hands down, hands up etc

Clap hands, bend knees, clap hands, bend knees etc.

**P.E.** You could:

- play in the garden
- Make an obstacle course
- Play ball games
- Practise throwing and catching a ball
- Make up a dance routine
- Do a Joe Wicks workout
- Go for a walk/bike ride
