

Year 1 Instructions for Thursday 23rd April 2020.

Good Morning! Keep enjoying the sunshine.

Phonics: Choose a session from Mrs. Jervis that you haven't done. Then go onto www.phonicsplay.co.uk click on Phase 5 and scroll down to alternative spellings igh. Click on it then click on phoneme spotter, read through the Kite Festival together. See how many different ways the igh sound is spelt whilst reading it, make a note. Then click the reveal button and see if you got all them all.

Maths: Watch Numberblocks (Cbeebies Iplayer) choose episode titled "fourteen" reminding you about doubling numbers.

Mentally What is double 6?, double 5?, double 4?

We will be looking at equal groups again, following on from yesterday's lesson. You will need some objects (eg lego bricks, buttons, beads). Complete the following questions practically using the objects. Write the question and answer in your Maths books.

| 5. Make 7 groups of 2 objects | 7 groups of 2 = |

Answer this question, show the answer practically and then as a picture in your Maths book.
