Good morning! Hope you had fun yesterday, remember to get outside and play in the sunshine.

Phonics: Choose one of Mrs. Jervis's phonics session on home learning page that you haven't done.

Practise writing the sentences This chicken quacks like a duck.

The cheeky fox is scratching and kicking.

Maths: Mental Maths count in 2s and 10s.

We will be continuing with doubling numbers.

Go onto www.topmarks.co.uk in search put doubling Key Stage 1. Choose the game Maths Fishing. Choose the first game (recall and use doubles of all numbers to 10).

Then complete the doubling sheets on the home learning page. Use counters/objects to help answer the questions.

English (skills) We are looking at the past tense, this is writing about something that has already happened.

On You Tube watch Nesy Reading Strategy, adding ed, verbs and the Nesy Reading Strategy ed song.

Remember verbs are doing/action words and when you are writing in the past tense you will generally add ed to the verb. Eg look ---- looked walk-----walked.

Have a go at the sheet attached to the home learning.

D.T. make a model of your house using recycled materials. Decide what materials you would like to use, how big a model you would like to do and what detail you want to include. You may decide to draw a design first and label the materials you are going to use.
