Then have a go at writing these sentences. Remember there are 4 ways to write the 'f' sound: f, ff, ph, gh (as in cough, rough, tough).

Then complete the attached reasoning question linked to finding a half (Parents you will need to remove the answers first).

Your work does not need to be in complete sentences, think about the words and phrases you can use. Remember neat handwriting, letters formed correctly.
