English: Finish your plan if it still needs completing. Then we are moving onto the Write. In your books you will need to write up your interview in sentences. Just choose one section to write about today. Eg school.

Things to remember:

Write your heading first

Draw a picture/stick in a photograph.

Write your sentences. Remember to write them in the past tense as it has already happened. Don't forget capital letters, finger spaces, full stops.

Neat handwriting, form those letters correctly all letters start from the top, none from the bottom, use letter formation sheet to remind you.

Make your sentences really interesting for the reader.

Think it, say it, write it. Make sure your sentences make sense.

Geography: Think about the walk you did on Monday for History looking at different places. Or think about a local route you know very well. You are going to make a messy map to show your walk. A messy map is when you use different objects to make your map. So you may choose to use sticks to make the roads, cardboard boxes to make the buildings, stones to show trees etc. It's up to you. Make your map outside in your garden and then you need to take a picture of it from above, (remember a map is a bird's eye view.) Remember each thing needs to be the same object so if you decide to use sticks for roads, all the roads need to besticks. Experiment have fun and see what you come up with.
