

Year 2 Instructions for Tuesday 21st April 2020

Good morning! Hope you had fun yesterday, remember to take time out to enjoy the sunshine and play.

Spelling: We are continuing to look at contractions using apostrophes. On the home learning page is an apostrophe booklet. Have a go at the first 2 exercises. Apostrophe Ants and Andrew Apostrophe. Remember it is 2 words contracted into one and the apostrophe goes where the letters are missing. E.g I'll -----I will.

Maths: Mental Maths can you count in thirds to 10.

We are continuing finding $\frac{3}{4}$ s of a number. If needed, you could watch the lesson 1 video again on White Rose Maths. Complete the worksheet attached to home learning page. Use different ways to help you find the answer. If the number isn't too big you could use objects round the house to help you or you could use a bar model (example below). Remember you need to split the number into 4 equal groups first and then work out how many is in 3 of the groups to find the answer.

Eg 24

24 split equally into 4 groups makes 6 24 shared by 4 equals 6.

So $\frac{3}{4}$ of 24 is $6+6+6$ which is 18.

You could use numbers or draw circles in the bar model to help you.

English: (Skills) We are looking at writing in the past tense and what we need to do to the verb of the sentence. Remember verbs are doing/action words and the general rule is that ed is added to the end of the word. Eg look -----looked , walk-----walked. Remember sometimes you may need to double the consonant hop----hopped, or drop the y and add i carry----carried. Complete the worksheet attached to home learning.

To help you may want to watch Nessy Reading Strategy adding ed on Youtube.

D.T. make a model of your house using recycled materials. Decide what materials you would like to use, how big a model you would like to do and what detail you want to include. You may decide to draw a design first and label the materials you are going to use.
