	A timeline of ancient Greece
492 BC	The Greeks begin a war with Persia.
490 BC	The Greeks win the Battle of Marathon, one of the most famous battles of the Persian War.
c.1200 BC	The Trojan War is fought between the ancient Greek city-states and the city of Troy.
776 BC	The first Olympic Games take place. They are held in honour of the god Zeus.
750-700 BC	The great poet Homer writes two epic poems about the Trojan War called the <i>Iliad</i> and the <i>Odyssey</i> .
850-700 BC	The Greek alphabet is developed.
510 BC	The great mathematician Pythagoras starts his own school.
508 BC	The system of democracy, where citizens can vote for people to be their representatives in a government, is introduced in Athens.
621 BC	A lawgiver named Draco brings in strict laws for the people of Athens to follow. These laws make most crimes punishable by death and are known as Draconian laws.
600 BC	Greek coins are introduced.
525 BC	Red-figure pottery is invented in Athens.
