Count forwards and backwards to 20 starting at different numbers.

Using the bus 10 frame and passengers (I have reattached to home learning if needed) Answer the following questions, how could you write them down? If you need a challenge try using 2 buses and think of questions up to 20.

- 1. There were 8 people on the bus, 4 people got off, how many are left on the bus?
- 2. There were 9 people on the bus, 6 people got off, how many are left on the bus?
- 3. There were 10 people on the bus, now there are only 8. How many people got off?
- 4. There were 4 people on the bus, now there is only 1. How many people got off?
- 5. There are only 4 people on the bus now, 6 people had got off, how many people were there at the start of the journey?

If you want some more Maths practise try the first, then, now worksheet.

Literacy: Attached are some pencil control worksheets to practise controlling your pencil, try and keep on the lines and try not to lift your pencil off the page until the end of the line.
