

EYFS Instructions for Friday 15th May 2020

Good Morning! I cannot believe we have reached the end of another week. Thank you all for working so hard. I am really proud of you all adapting to this new way of learning so well. I have enjoyed looking at your work. Hopefully I will see you all very soon.

Phonics: Join in with one of Mrs. Jervis's sessions on the home learning page. Then complete Phonics Activity Mat 4 (in May 7th on home learning page if needed). Try reading the following sentences: Remember to look out for those tricky words and small words you can read straightaway, keep going back to beginning of the sentence as you sound out the words to keep the understanding.

1. I can boast that I had toast for my lunch.
2. I think that pink socks might be the best.
3. If you feel down in the dumps then jump up and sing.

Maths: Numberblocks (Cbeebies iPlayer) I can count to twenty. Play Bud's Number Garden (BBC Bitesize KS1 Maths) there are several games to choose from. Try ordering numbers from 1-20. You can use the sheet attached to the home learning page, or you could have some help writing out the numbers either in chalk outside or on paper. Can you count them in order. Now try and read the numeral and put the right number of objects next to the number. Which ones could you read and count by yourself? Which ones did you need help with?

Literacy: Thinking about the book On the way home by Jill Murphy, You could:

Choose a favourite part of the story and either do a painting/collage/drawing of it. Draw a map of Claire's journey and see if you can put the tales she tells in the right order (drawing or writing them in). Which friends does she meet? Retell the story in your own words to someone at home. Make up your own story, you could draw it or write it or act it out in your garden/house using props. Make a "Messy Map" of Claire's journey, that is using objects to make a 3D map of the journey, Eg sticks for roads, model animals for the animals she meets. You could write out some labels too. Find out about where crocodiles, gorillas live and write some sentences about it.

Music: Go onto www.charanga.com and explore Round and round, Big Bear Funk or Your Imagination.

Don't forget to spend time reading and sharing books.
