EYFS Instructions for Monday 11th May 2020

Phonics: Complete a phonics session from Mrs. Jervis.

On <u>www.phonicsplay.co.uk</u> play giggling graphemes Phase 2 and 3 and play Tricky word trucks Phase 3 and 4.

Maths: On Cbeebies iPlayer watch Numberblocks episode "nineteen".

We will be looking at taking away this week. Collect up to 20 different objects and set them out in line, count how many you have got. Then have a go at the following questions, think about how you could write down the number sentence. Try and do a few yourself too.

- 1. Count out 12 objects, then take away 4 objects. How many do you have now?
- 2. Count out 15 objects, then take away 5 objects. How many do you have now?
- 3. Count out 9 objects, then take away 3 objects. How many do you have now?
- 4. Count out 17 objects then take away 6 objects. How many do you have now?
- 5. Count out 8 objects then take away 8 objects. How many do you have now?
- 6. Now make some of your own take away calculations using your objects.

Literacy: Read the story On the Way Home by Jill Murphy (Lots of storytellers on You Tube reading the story if you don't have the book).

Draw a map from your house to school. What could you pass on the way? Draw and label the different things you pass they can be real or imaginary. You may want to pass a dragon or a castle or a huge ice cream shop, it's up to you.
