Maths: Go onto Numberblocks Cbeebie iPlayer (Episode Fun times fair)

Play the matching game to 20 (attached to home learning) Write the numeral 15 on a piece of paper and find different ways to make 15 using objects from around the house. Count out 15 objects. What is one less than 15? Write the numeral What is one more than 15? Write the numeral.

Literacy: Handwriting practice Curly caterpillar letters. Remember they all start from the same place. See Letter formation sheets sent originally if unsure.

EAD: You could: Draw or paint a picture from the story Six Dinner Sid Make a paper plate pet (see sheet) Make a pet rock (see sheet) Design a new toy for Tigger Build a habitat for your favourite animal Role play caring for an animal. How would you look after a pet? Build a zoo/farm/vets/pet shop.
