Geography

Finish your map first if you haven't completed it. Then write a fact file about the geography of Greece. Use Google Earth, images of Greek landscapes and the internet to help. A good website is **Ducksters geography of Greece.**

Explore: the weather and climate of Greece. (Year 5/6 – can you also see if you can find the longitude and latitude of Athens). Please avoid telling me it is just hot/cold etc, more specific detail is needed. Is it an arid, tropical, temperate climate? Look at the where Greece is in relation to the equator or the poles to help. Does Greece have seasons? A rainy season? Find out about the physical features of Greece, does it have a coastline? rivers? mountains? deserts? Where are they? Can you name any of the rivers/seas/mountains etc. (Y5/6 - Can you also find the main differences between the terrain of mainland Greece and the islands? What do I mean by terrain?)

Can you name any major settlements? What is the capital city of Greece? How big is the population? (Year 5/6 Is the population of Greece more than or less than the UK?)

Which continent is Greece on? Draw a small sketch map on your fact file, include photographs, use subheadings to help. You will have a couple of weeks to do this so take your time to produce a good quality piece of work.
