

Monday 11th May y4 + 5+ 6

Today is your final write. You should write an expanded set of instructions to your army. Your planning notes should be expanded and improved upon to create clear instructions which also inspire the soldiers to believe that you will win this war if these instructions are followed carefully. The reader should hear a clear, strong, brave tone of voice. The reader should believe that the voice has confidence and command. Imagine that you are a high commander and you stand up and your army stretches out before you as far as the eye can see and you give these instructions and motivate all the men to carry them out to end the long war.

Keep self-editing throughout and when you finish writing, read it together with an adult to edit again. Are there any higher level words to use? Would sentence length or word order alter the effect? Is that the best commanding verb to use? Can I add adverbs to this instruction? Can I add some words of inspiration here? How shall I end these instructions if I want the soldiers to rush to follow the instructions carefully with the belief that these instructions will lead to an end to the war that they all yearn for.

Look carefully at your plan.

Remember to include all the elements of building the horse and tricking the Trojans.

In your final write...
