
## Fortune Teller

This week we are looking at the sound /or/ spelt 'a' before I or II


## **Instructions**


With pictures face down, fold on both diagonal lines. Unfold.




Turn paper over.




Once again, fold all corners to the centre.

Fold paper in half and unfold.


