What have the Greeks done for us?

How did your research about the Ancient Greeks go? Have you chosen the topic you want to create a powerpoint about?

Remember, this term's task is to select one of the parts of Greek life that interests you most and create a powerpoint about it.

You will need to:

- Research and collect facts about your chosen area of Greek life.
- Build up a powerpoint or fact file if you don't have powerpoint.
- Insert images and video clips into your presentation.
- Be creative with fonts and presentation.

Week 2

If you have done your research, you can start to build your powerpoint.

The priority is to get down the facts you want. Include an introduction to your topic. Once you have the facts and information, you can start to add images and videos (if appropriate). DO NOT spend your time focussing on fonts and backgrounds until you have your facts and information put down.

Keep it simple. Select new slides for new pieces of information, so there isn't too much writing on each slide. Put any facts you find into your own words.

Adding an image

To add an image, it is easiest to go to snipping tool Left click on the image you want to copy and, holding down the left button, drag the snipping tool across the image you want.

You can now return to your powerpoint, paste the image on to the slide you want. Once it is pasted in , you can re-size it and place it where you want.

If you don't have snipping tool, you need to right click on the image you want and select 'copy'. Unfortunately this does not always allow you to copy the image, so you may have to select an alternative one.

You could research one or more of:

- Daily life
- Gods and Godesses
- Festivals and games
- Sparta
- Greek art
- Troy
- Greek clothing
- Food and drink
- Something of your choosing

Your research could include:

- When the Ancient Greeks lived
- Who the Ancient Greeks were- was there a hierarchy e.g. wealthy, servants, poor?
- What their homes were like
- What their beliefs were
- What they wore
- Whether you could tell someone's status by their clothing
- What they did for leisure
- Who was allowed to participate in leisure activities

Try to stick to ideas which are linked, rather than using little bits of information from all over the place.
