

EYFS Instructions for Tuesday 2nd June 2020

Good Morning! I hope you all enjoyed the sunshine yesterday and enjoyed making different patterns with Superworm.

Phonics: Complete a Phase 3 or Phase 4 session with Mrs. Jervis. (You may want to revisit a sound you are unsure of).

Practise reading the tricky words have, like, some, come

Go onto www.phonicsplay.co.uk and go onto Phase 4 and play Buried Treasure. (Choose revise all Phase 4).

Read the sentence: Will you come and have some roast bugs on toast for dinner?

Maths: Watch Numberblocks on Cbeebies iPlayer, series 2, episode double trouble.

We are going to be looking at doubling numbers. Attached to home learning page is doubling butterflies sheet. Draw the same number of spots on each side of the butterfly (no more than 12 spots on one side). Then count the number spots and find out how many there are altogether and write the number sentence underneath the butterfly.

For example: Draw 2 spots on each side of the butterfly and then write $2+2=4$.

Literacy: Think about all the different jobs Superworm does. Now think what else he could be. Draw a picture of him and write a sentence underneath telling me what Superworm does.

Other activities you could do:

Design and make your own minibeast, what could it be? What could you call it?

There are some craft ideas on home learning page you might like to do.

Build a minibeast hotel in your garden using natural materials

Go on a minibeast hunt, what can you find?

Find out about earthworms using the internet.

Make symmetrical butterflies using handprints.

Who in your family can make the longest worm using different materials?

Remember to go outside and enjoy the sunshine and continue to share and read books with someone at home.
