


#### How would you group living things?




### Aristotle had a bright idea...



He knew that living things all shared MRS **NERG** in common however some living things were better than others...


#### He then thought some more...

 Aristotle also concluded that some plants were better than others so split these into smaller groups too.



 Protoctista Kingdom – single cell organisms with a nucleus, pond algae is a protoctista





 Monera Kingdom – bacteria, no nucleus, can live almost anywhere they divide to reproduce





 Fungi Kingdom – don't make food instead they live off decaying plants, there are about 70,000 known fungi!





 Animalia Kingdom – There are so many different types of animals that is why we classify them into detailed groups.









• <u>Plantae</u> – There are so many different types of plants that is why we classify them into more detailed groups. Plants use photosynthesis to make their own food.
