Geography: Read the story of Icarus and Daedulus attached to Home Learning Page.

Y3/4 Using digital maps or an atlas find the 2 islands Crete and Sicily. Daedulus flew from Crete to Sicily, decide which route he could have taken. Did he go over land or sea? On the blank map mark on Crete and Sicily and then draw the route Daedulus could have taken. Which would be the fastest route? Over land or sea? Why?

Y5/6 Using digital maps or an atlas find the 2 islands Crete and Sicily. Somewhere on your map will be a scale (usually in a bottom corner).

Decide which route Daedulus could have taken to escape. Draw the route onto the blank map and mark on Crete and Sicily. Using the scale, find out how far the journey you chose is in km. Can you find a shorter route? What is the actual distance between the 2 islands in km?
