Then talk to parents , write the title and poet if you can and write a sentence about each poetry feature below:

1. Rhythm (Is it a fast or slow beat/rhythm?)
2. Verse form (Is the poem just one verse? How many lines? More than one verse? Same number of lines in each verse?)
3. Is there any alliteration in this poem? (words that start with the same sound)
4. Is there any rhyme? Does it follow a pattern? E.g every line rhymes every 2 lines rhyme?
