Today you are going to make some planning notes about your poem.

Listen to Ms. P talks...poetry first to find out what was important to me at the planning stage of my poem.

First of all, I want you to write about being a Spartan unless you have a burning desire to write about a different aspect of Ancient Greece. If so, that is fine.

Otherwise, you can magpie (copy) the title if you like:

I AM SPARTAN. FEAR MY NAME

as Spartans were famous for their warrior skills, bravery, strength, determination and resilience.

Planning Headings:

Title: (you can magpie mine if you like)

Verse form: (one long verse or short verses of 2 lines each or 4 lines each)

Rhyme: (decide if you want to have rhyme and write out some rhyming pairs that you might use)

Alliteration: (where the first letter of the first word is the same...write down some examples that you might use)
