Hello Y3

Today, you are going to sequence these dates vertically. Ask an adult to help you. You will draw a line in the middle of your page and write year 0 at the top (birth of Christ).

When you put these dates in order remember that 333 BC (before Christ) is **CLOSER** to year 0, at the top of your timeline, and that 340 BC is **further away** than year 0, at the top of your timeline.

Just before you start, watch the History horse-taming file (showing a video clip of a 13 year old Alexander) and Clever Solution file (showing Alexander as a young man when faced with an impossible task to prove that he would rule Asia).

Now use the jumbled up dates below to create your timeline.
