# Bianca Andreescu Wins US Open

On Saturday, September 8<sup>th</sup>, nineteen-year-old Bianca Andreescu made history by winning the US Open tennis tournament in Flushing Meadows-Corona Park, New York. She became the first Canadian ever to win a Grand Slam singles title. (In this case, a *Grand Slam* event is one of the four most important tennis tournaments played each year.)

She beat veteran tennis player Serena Williams, age 37.

The crowd at Arthur Ashe Stadium in Flushing Meadows, New York, was rooting for Williams, who is from the United States. The pressure was on Andreescu throughout the match, who at one point put her fingers in her ears to try to block out the loudly cheering crowd.
