Today you are going to make some planning notes about your poem.

Listen to **Ms. P talks...poetry** first to find out what was important to me at the planning stage of my poem.

First of all, I want you to write about being a Spartan unless you have a burning desire to write about a different aspect of Ancient Greece. If so, that is fine.

Otherwise, you can magpie the title if you like:

I AM SPARTAN. FEAR MY NAME

as Spartans were famous for their warrior skills, bravery, strength, determination and resilience.

Planning Headings:
