



## Year 2 Instructions for Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020.

**Spelling:** This week we are looking at words that end in “tion” (making a shun sound). Write a list of words that have the “tion” sound at the end that you can think of and try spelling them remember the shun sound will be spelt tion. For example station or attention. See how many you can think of. Perhaps look in a favourite book and see if you can find any tion words.

**Maths:** What multiplication sentences do the following arrays show? Remember they will show 2 multiplication number sentences.
