Covid19 Restrictions

Following the government's announcement, on the 14th of June, that the remaining restrictions would not be relaxed until the 19th of July at the earliest, there have been a number of changes to our proposed end of year activities. Stokesley School has unfortunately cancelled all their cluster sporting events and transition days for the children starting at their new schools have also been cancelled. This is obviously very disappointing for everyone but this week two local primary schools have had positive cases and have had to send children home so we need to be careful. The DFE has sent guidance to all schools advising against any indoor events, including leavers' assemblies, however, the good news is that schools are allowed to hold sports days outside, providing that there are groups of no more than 30 people. There can be multiple groups of 30, but these groups need to be separate and, within the groups, families must remain socially distanced from other families. It will take some careful planning and organisation but I am so pleased that it can go ahead.

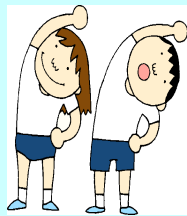

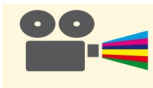
PHILOSOPHY CLUB KS2
