Dear Parents and Carers

Well, we definitely spoke too soon. It was finally Osmotherley Schools turn to be disrupted by a Covid outbreak after being so fortunate to avoid it for so long! Thank you for your patience and understanding when I had to close the whole school on Monday 24th and the Oaks class on Tuesday 25th. I am very pleased that we were able to open fully by Wednesday, despite the positive cases among the staff. Thank you also for keeping an eye on your children and testing them or keeping them at home when they were displaying symptoms. I really appreciate your help. Hopefully, everyone will be back by next week and we can get back to our usual routines. The children are looking forward to the upcoming coding events that have been arranged for both classes. The first event is on Thursday afternoon next week. I'm sure the children will enjoy being taught by a computing expert and the plans looks very exciting. Unfortunately, we had to cancel our planned visit to the 'Supermobile' library last week. It was a real shame because the children loved the visit in December and were keen to swap their books. I informed the library service and they told me that the books can be returned at any time and they don't issue fines! The Supermobile will call at Osmotherley again between 10am and 12pm on Thursday 24th February. This is during half term, but the children are welcome to go with their families. The children will visit again in March.

The Spring term parent consultations are scheduled for Monday 14th and Tuesday 15th February (appointment times will be sent out shortly). The consultations will take place over the phone but the teachers will arrange for you to see your children's books.

Our end of term celebration assembly will take place as planned on Friday 18th February. I will let you know nearer the time whether we can hold it in school or whether it will need to be online.

From next half term, the KS2 children will have Forest School sessions every three weeks instead of fortnightly. This decision has been taken to ensure that there is enough time to focus on areas of the science curriculum that cannot easily be covered outdoors (e.g. electricity). The Reception and KS1 children will continue to have Forest School sessions on alternate weeks.

Finally, this half term, we were delighted to welcome two children into our school family. Ottilie and Ralph have settled in beautifully in their new classes and have both made a super start.
