We were deeply saddened by the news of the death of Her Majesty the Queen. As a school, we send our thoughts and condolences to the Royal Family at this time. During the period of national mourning, we will be reflecting on the Queen's reign and commemorating her incredible life of service through special assemblies in school. The Queen's funeral will be held on Monday 19th September, which will be an additional bank holiday so school will be closed.

New Academic Year 2022-23

After the long holiday, it is always a treat to see the children again on the first day back at school. It is also lovely to welcome the new children in Reception. So far, they are settling in beautifully. Thank you to the Acorns team for helping them to get off to such a good start.

The children in the Saplings and Oaks classes have stayed with the same teachers so they have been able to make a flying start with their learning.

Reading

Thank you to all the parents who supported their children with their reading, spelling and times tables recall over the holidays. This year we will strive to instil a love of reading in all of our pupils, as research has shown that a love of reading is the strongest indicator of future educational success. We appreciate your support with this aim.

Learning - Core and Foundation Subjects

The teachers will share the essential knowledge that pupils are expected to learn in all the foundation subjects. The children are developing a good understanding of the importance of deliberately practising skills until they are fluent and in recalling knowledge in quizzes (or recalls) to help them to remember. Learning is defined by an alteration to long-term memory so our curriculum is designed to help children to learn in small steps that build and make connections with previous learning. Attendance and Punctuality

Attendance and punctuality have a huge impact on your child's learning. Children who frequently miss days of school or who arrive late, miss steps in their learning which have to be caught up. Learning moves at a pace, right from Reception, so it is important to ensure that children attend if at all possible (although they should not attend if they are too unwell, e.g. they have a high temperature or if they have had sickness or diarrhoea within the last 48 hours). Term-time holidays are not authorised, except in exceptional circumstances, for the reasons outlined above and the DFE plan to issue fines rather that leaving this to the discretion of headteachers.

Online Safety

The pupils from Y2 to Y6 are developing excellent computer literacy by having the use of their own chrome book. At school, they are closely supervised when they are online and the school has installed the highest safety settings and internet safety is an important part of the computing and the PSHE curriculum. At home, parents and carers need to be equally vigilant. We can never be too careful.
