Ofsted Inspection

All the staff at school are very pleased that we finally received our long-awaited visit from Ofsted just before half term. The result remains confidential until we receive the final report but we are allowed to say that we are smiling and we are looking forward to sharing it. The children were fantastic, as always, and thank you for all the wonderful feedback from parents and carers on Parent View. I am delighted that the inspector was able to see the celebration assembly because it was gorgeous, as always, and it clearly showed how much the children are proud of their learning and how well supported we are by our families.

Future Plans

Osmotherley School and Osmotherley Pre-School have been working together since last summer to ensure that the excellent provision that our pre-school children have enjoyed for many years can be preserved. Today parents and carers will receive a letter containing a proposal for the future of early years education for the children of Osmotherley and the surrounding areas. We have agreed that Osmotherley Primary School will apply to extend its age-range from 4 -11 years to 3 -11 years so that 3 year olds will be able to join the early year s class in school from January 2024. The first step in this process is to consult with parents and carers. We will keep you informed about any further developments.

PE Days This Half Term

James Lofthouse is leading PE on Mondays for both classes with a focus on athletics skills in preparation for our annual Sports Day. Acorns will have PE on alternate Fridays – when they haven't had Forest School. KS2 pupils have swimming on Thursdays so they will not have PE on Fridays this half term.

During the last half-term of the year there is always a lot of talk about moving on and moving up and the leavers' service which can be unsettling for some children. In addition to the 3 taster days for the Y6 pupils at their secondary schools, we have also arranged a science workshop at Northallerton School and we have planned some taster days for the rest of the children so that their new classes will be familiar in September and they can enjoy the summer break.

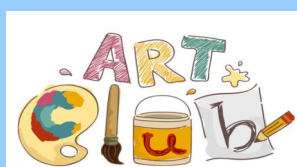
