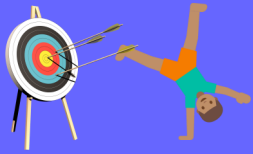

(EYFS children can join in after Easter).

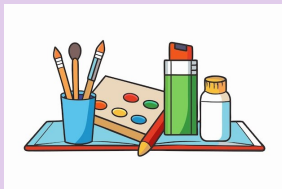
Please arrive at 8.20am. Children can wear joggers or leggings with their school tops all day but they will need a change of shoes .
