#### **VE Day picnic**

The children were treated to a splendid picnic lunch, kindly prepared by the catering staff at Northallerton School. It was a little bit chilly but that didn't spoil the fun and it was a lovely way to celebrate 80 years of peace.

#### SATs

It was SATs week last week and we couldn't have been prouder of our three Year 6 pupils for their calm and mature approach to the five test papers. We also had an unannounced monitoring visit to check that the tests were being administered according to the strict rules. Even the inspector commented on how impressive the children were. Well done to them and to Ms Pickard for all their hard work. Best of all, the SATS are out of the way so we can focus on preparing the Year 6s as well as possible for their move to secondary school.

#### **Carlton Lodge**

Last week the Year 3 and 4 children went to Carlton Lodge for a 2 day outward bound residential visit. This is the first time that the Year 3 and 4 children have been offered an overnight stay but we will certainly be doing it again. It was brilliant! The children tried all kinds of activities, including stand-up paddle-boarding, archery, climbing and orienteering. The children made their own beds and their own sandwiches for lunch. They rose to the challenge and had a really wonderful time. This experience will help to prepare them for the 2-night residential visits to Robinwood and Liverpool in Year 5 and 6.
